Een 'Circular Valley', een 'Health Hub' of een 'Smart Space Cluster'. Je kunt het zo gek niet bedenken of er bestaat wel een initiatief dat Nederland als 'toonaangevend topcentrum' op een bepaald gebied op de kaart wil zetten, zo blijkt uit een inventarisatie door het FD. Dat elk initiatief de gedroomde ambities kan waarmaken is wishful thinking, stellen experts.

In totaal zijn er in Nederland zo'n 220 initiatieven te vinden die ondernemers, ambtenaren, burgers en onderzoekers aansporen om te vernieuwen. De samenwerkingsverbanden en organisaties

jaar een miljard aan investeringen in Drenthe, Groningen en Friesland uitlokken en 6500 banen creëren.

Naast de vele overlegorganen zijn er 32 campussen en 20 technologieparken waar innovatie het sleutelwoord is. Zo wil Veenendaal met zijn ICT Campus 'de ICT-stad van FoodValley' worden, en wordt er in Marknesse gewerkt aan een 'Geomatics Businesspark', de 'toplocatie voor innovatieve en kennisintensieve organisaties'. Bijna elk initiatief heeft wel een marketingfilm met opzwepende muziek die buitenlandse ondernemers en onderzoekers het gevoel moet geven dat Nederland de 'place to be' is.







New regional competitiveness index demonstrates Utrecht strengths.

To improve the understanding of competitiveness at the regional level, the JRC's Institute for the Protection and Security of the Citizen (IPSC), together with the Commission's Directorate-General for Regional Policy, has developed a new index to demonstrate the strengths and weaknesses of each of the 271 EU regions.

Utrecht ranked number one on the competitiveness index which incorporates a wide range of issues related to competitiveness including innovation, quality of institutions, infrastructure (including digital networks) and measures of health and human capital, and will be a crucial tool in assisting EU regions to set the right priorities to further increase their competitiveness. 


Impact of tariffs on integrated supply chain - Tier 1

GKN Driveline – Illustration of an integrated supply chain


A typical driveline system produced by GKN incorporates specialist parts largely from the rest of the EU.

GKN sources specialist forged parts from Spain, Italy, France and Germany which are then assembled at GKN Driveline's factory in the UK and supplied to UK and EU OEMs.





Brexit total producer price increase by NUTS 2 regions


